*2020-2021 Return to School Considerations & Preparations*




*Advanced Action*, MVM's 2020-2021 return to school plan, is guided by our goal to have our enrolled students physically present in school and our commitment to supporting the overall health and well-being of all children, adolescents, their families, and extended communities and our compliance with national, state and local guidelines for school communities.

Our MVM community has a range and diversity of ages and abilities. Considerations and accommodations must be flexible and fluid so we can consistently and cohesively meet the changing needs of all students and families with the goal of maintaining safe and healthy environments.

*Advanced Action* follows a uniform set of practical and appropriate procedures for our student's developmental stages and can be revised and adapted depending on an increase or decrease of the virus in the larger community.

*Advanced Action* requires a cooperative and collaborative partnership between MVM and our enrolled families through a commitment to healthy preventative practices and upfront transparent communication and reporting.

*Advanced Action* has 4 key components



# SCREENING

## *Premise*

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*Preventative practices when entering the building each day is key to mitigating the spread and transmission of COVID-19.*

### *Procedures*

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- ***Controlled Points of Entry***
  - » *Temperature Check*
  - » *Face Masks*
  - » *Spray Shoes*
  - » *Wash hands and Sanitize*
  - » *Outdoor classroom entry*
- ***Visitors – (Deliveries, Licensing/Audit, Repairs/Inspections, Parents)***
  - » *By Appointment Only*
  - » *Single Point of Entry*
  - » *Face Masks*
  - » *Wash Hands and Sanitize*
  - » *Spray Shoes*
- ***Events***
  - » *All socials, fundraisers and other group events are cancelled for 2020-2021*
  - » *No in school events that include any visitors/guests*
- ***Symptom screening***
  - » *Staff and students*
  - » *Temperature checks*
  - » *Rapid response*
  - » *Send home*
  - » *Testing*
  - » *Quarantine if necessary*

### *Equipment*

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- ***Infrared Point and Scan Thermometers (administration)***
- ***Thermometers all classrooms***
- ***Sanitizer dispensers installed in classrooms and throughout school***
- ***Outdoor and indoor handwashing stations***

# SANITIZATION AND PREVENTION

## *Premise*

*Routine cleaning practices that include EPA approved normal cleaning with soap and water decreases the viral load and optimizes the efficacy of disinfectants. Use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and proper ventilation are all utilized to mitigate/prevent the spread of COVID-19.*

### ***Procedures***

- ***All School Daily Operations (Custodial Support Assistant)***
  - » *Three times a day all community touch points are cleaned*
  - » *Dishes for all classrooms*
  - » *Sanitize Library and Community Room tables and chairs*
  - » *Kitchens*
  - » *Bathrooms*
- ***Classroom Daily Operations (Teachers and Assistants)***
  - » *Table and chairs cleaned at end of individual use*
  - » *Tables assigned daily strongly recommended K-8*
  - » *Electrostatic fogger 2x per week*
  - » *Virucide 2x a month by cleaning service*
  - » *Touch point cleaned 3x per day*
  - » *Door handles, classroom faucets, etc.*
  - » *Shared materials cleaned after each use*
  - » *Minimize porous/soft surfaces*
    - \* *Rugs, mats, felt mats, place mats, napkins, table clothes, chair cushions, etc.*
  - » *Handwashing/Sanitizer*
- ***Outdoor play equipment (Aftercare Assistants)***
  - » *Early childhood and sand box toys sanitized 2x per day*
  - » *Sanitize balls at minimum 2X per week*
  - » *Play structures sanitized at minimum 2X per week*
- ***Ventilation***
  - » *Windows and doors open when possible*

- ***Laundry***
  - » *Gloves must be worn (single use only)*
  - » *Laundry baskets must be non-porous and sanitized daily*
- ***Cottage Industry lunches***
  - » *Food safety and hygiene standards upheld*
- ***Bathrooms***

### ***Equipment***

- ***Upgrade induct HVAC system to MERV-15 level filters and run fan system for continuous air flow***
- ***Air purifiers (being investigated)***
- ***Electrostatic foggers***
- ***Thermometers***
- ***Stationary Dispensers***

# SOCIAL DISTANCING

## *Premise*

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*Physical distancing with the goal of limiting the spread of communicable diseases between individuals is fundamental to lowering the risk of spread of the virus.*

### *Procedures*

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- ***Limit group Sizes***
  - » *Increase classroom areas to utilize outside and/or community room to allow students to work 3-6 ft apart*
  - » *Minimize crossover between age groups, classrooms and community areas*
  - » *Minimizing movement through the greater school*
- ***Classroom Transitions***
  - » *Greeting*
  - » *Dismissal*
  - » *Nap*
  - » *Playground*
  - » *Bathroom*
  - » *Library*
  - » *Office*
- ***Before and After care***
  - » *Minimize crossover between age groups, classrooms and community areas*
  - » *Lower and upper elementary groups*

### *Equipment*

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- ***Materials and equipment to extend classroom environments***
- ***While weather is favorable, utilize outdoor areas adjacent the classrooms***
- ***Set up work areas in Community Room***

# SCHOOL AND FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES

## *Premise*

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*All members of our MVM community are expected to work in partnership and act responsibly at school and home by: 1) embracing the serious nature of COVID-19, 2) demonstrating proper health and safety standards, 3) following health and safety guidelines issued by local, state, and federal agencies, 4) identifying changes in health conditions and/or exposure to individuals diagnosed with COVID-19, 5) reporting as a means to inform action and prevent transmission and spread of COVID-19.*
